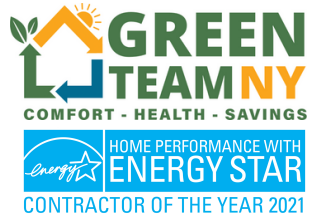


NEW FUNDING AVAILABLE FOR HEAP/SNAP RECIPIENTS

*Includes funding for
electrification of
heating/cooling,
building envelope and
water heating.*

NYSERDA and the Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) has released \$26.7 million in ARPA funding to be available immediately to help HEAP and SNAP recipients move their homes towards beneficial electrification.

This funding will allow for worksopes of up to \$20,000 per home (in addition to utility incentives) for insulation, air sealing and the installation of heat pump technology through the EmPower New York Program.



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Participation Requirements:

If receiving heat pumps, the home must meet insulation requirements at time of completion of project.

Heat pump incentives (can be combined with NY Clean Heat Program).

To be eligible, a home must meet the following guidelines:

- Be a HEAP or SNAP recipient with award letter showing CIN (includes Long Island) dated October 1, 2021 or later.
- Project must be completed by September 30, 2022.
- If receiving heat pumps, home must meet minimum insulation levels at time of project completion.
- For oil, propane, kerosene, electric, and wood heated homes, heat pumps will be pre-qualified measures. For natural gas heating homes, the efficiency of the equipment being replaced cannot exceed 80% and the total project for a natural gas heated home must have positive bill savings.
